#### **Starting School in 2026**



From **1 November 2025**, applications will open for parents to apply for their child (born between 01 September 2021 – 31 August 2022) to start school in September 2026. The closing date for applications is **15 January 2026**.

Parents will be able to apply online via the Hampshire County Council website: www.hants.gov.uk/educationandlearning/admissions. Paper forms will also be

available from any Hampshire primary or infant school on request from 1 November. Full information about the application process can be found at:
